## STOCKS OF GRAIN, APRIL 1, 1945

Included in grain stocks in all storage positions, on and off farms, on tril 1, 1945, were 563 million bushels of wheat, 1,408 million bushels of corn, 9 million bushels of oats, 144 million bushels of barley and  $20\frac{1}{2}$  million bushels of rye. Current stocks of wheat are 3 percent larger than a year earlier, but 38 percent less than on April 1, 1943. Stocks of corn are 23 percent larger than a year ago, but 5 percent less than on April 1, 1943. Oats stocks are 6 percent larger than a year earlier, but 13 percent less than on April 1, 1943. Reserves of barley are 7 percent above a year ago, but 24 percent below 2 years ago, while rye stocks are down 44 percent from those of April 1, 1944 and 61 percent from those of April 1, 1943. These data do not include an estimate of grains in transit, of which reports indicate there is probably more than usual for this time of year.

Of the total of 2,605 million bushels of the five grains, about 2,103 million bushels were on farms, the difference of 502 million bushels being in off-farm storages. This is equivalent to about 30 percent of all commercial storage capacity, which at the time of the most recent survey on April 1, 1943, totaled 1,667 million bushels. A year earlier off-farm stocks of the five grains were 469 million bushels, equivalent to 28 percent of the total storage space, and on April 1, 1943, the off-farm total of 798 million bushels occupied 48 percent of the total commercial storage space. Disappearance of wheat from all positions between January 1 and April 1, 1945 was about 273 million bushels, the same as for this quarter of 1944. For the same respective periods, disappearance of corn was 794 and 880 million bushels; disappearance of oats was 332 and 311 million bushels; of barley 69 and 83 million bushels; and of rye 6.6 and 6.5 million bushels.

Stocks of corn, oats, barley and rye, shown by States below, are estimates for the off-farm positions covered by the Crop Reporting Board. These positions include all off-farm storages except those at the 46 terminal markets and the steel and wooden bins of Commodity Credit Corporation.
