STOCKS OF GRAIN, OCTOBER 1, 1945

Grain stocks in all positions, on and off farms on October 1, 1945 included 1,044 million bushels of wheat, 329 million bushels of corn, 1,419 million bushels of oats, 257 million bushels of barley and 22 million bushels of rye. Wheat stocks are about 4 percent smaller than on October 1, 1944 and 6 percent smaller than on October 1, 1943. Stocks of corn are about 40 percent larger than a year ago, but 15 percent smaller than on October 1, 1943. Oats reserves are also 40 percent larger than a year ago and 43 percent larger than 2 years ago. Barley stocks are 4 percent and 22 percent lower, respectively, than on October 1, 1944 and October 1, 1943. Rye stocks also dwindled to 38 percent below a year ago and 59 percent below October 1, 1943.

Combined stocks of these 5 grains total 3,071 million bushels, of which 2,353 million bushels were on farms and 718 million bushels were in off-farm storages. This quantity would occupy 45 percent of all off-farm storage capacity, which totaled 1,667 million bushels at the time of the most recent survey on April 1, 1943. Off-farm stocks of the 5 grains a year ago were 749 million bushels and on October 1, 1943, all off-farm stocks amounted to 794 million bushels, nearily half of the total commercial storage capacity. Supplies of wheat, oats, barley and rye at the beginning of a crop year are considered as the sum of the estimated new crop and the July 1 carry-over stocks. Disappearance from all storage positions for the period July 1 to October 1 is the computed difference between supply and October 1 stocks. The disappearance of wheat for this period in 1945 was 387 million bushels, compared w ith 305 million bushels in the same quarter of 1944 and 348 million bushels in 1943. For the same respective periods disappearance of oats was 403, 363, and 408 million bushels; of barley 117, 93 and 116 million bushels; of rye 18, 21 and 23 million bushels; of corn 455, 361 and 451 million bushels.

Stocks of corn, cats, barley and rye, shown by States below, are estimates for only those off-farm positions covered by the Crop Reporting Board. These positions include all off-farm storages except commercial stocks at terminals and Commodity Credit Corporation bins.
