STOCKS OF GRAIN, JULY 1, 1943

Stocks of 20,406,000 bushels of corn, 18,627,000 bushels of oats, 30,491,000 bushels of barley, and 8,524,000 bushels of rye from the 1942 and earlier crops were held on July 1 in commercial storage positions covered by estimates of the Crop Reporting Board of the U. S. Department of Agriculture. The coverage of stocks for this report includes those in Interior Mills, Elevators, and Warehouses, for which estimates of wheat stocks are made quarterly by the Crop Reporting Board, and in addition those in Merchant Mills and Oilseed Crushers, whose milling and crushing operations are reported by the Bureau of the Census, in other storages such as breweries, distilleries, bean cleaning and corn processing plants and similar miscellaneous plants not otherwise covered by any other government agency. This is the first survey covering these positions on July 1.

These stocks were in addition to stocks on farms published July 10 by the Crop Reporting Board, those at terminal markets in 46 cities reported by the Food Distribution Administration and the relatively small stocks of grain then held by Commodity Credit Corporation in their own steel and wooden bins. Stocks in all positions, compared with those on April 1, 1943, are shown for the United States in the table below:

Indications from several States important in the production of barley and rye point to heavy movements of these grains from farms to commercial storage during the period April 1 to July 1, 1943, preparatory to handling the 1943 crops. Although no similar July 1 survey has been made previously, stocks of corn in all commercial storages are known to be relatively small, since they are lower than those held at the 46 terminal markets alone on July 1 of most years since 1938. The aggregate stocks (including stocks in Merchant Mills*) of these 4 grains and wheat from the 1942 and earlier crops, at about 513,000,000* bushels, occupied about 31* percent of all commercial storage space which totaled 1,667,192,000 bushels as of April 1, 1943. New crop grains had already begun to move to storages by July 1, but are not included in these estimates.
