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STOCKS OF CORN, SOYBEANS AND WHEAT BELOW LAST YEAR

Total stocks of the four feed grains (corn, oats, barley and sorghum) on April 1, 1971, amounted to 98.4 million tons -- 16 percent less than the 116.7 million tons a year earlier, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Large declines in corn, sorghum and barley were only partially offset by a small increase in oats.

Stocks of all wheat were 11 percent smaller and durum wheat stocks 21 percent under a year earlier. Soybean holdings on April 1 were 16 percent below a year earlier. However, rye stocks were up 41 percent and flaxseed stocks up 23 percent from April 1, 1970.

All wheat in storage April 1 totaled 1,064 million bushels, 11 percent less than the year before and 4 percent below April 1, 1969. Off-farm stocks of 678 million bushels were 8 percent less than the preceding April 1 and farm holdings, at 386 million, were down 16 percent from the large total a year earlier. January-March disappearance is indicated at 353 million bushels, compared with 337 million a year earlier. The Commodity Credit Corporation owned 260 million bushels of the total wheat stocks and hand loans outstanding on 403 million.

Durum wheat stocks in all positions totaled 75.6 million bushels on April 1, 21 percent less than a year earlier but 11 percent above April 1, 1969. Farm holdings of 53.0 million were 34 percent below last year but off-farm stocks of 22.7 million bushels were up 38 percent. Disappearance during January-March is indicated at 14.5 million bushels, compared with 14.6 million for the same 1970 quarter.

Rye stocks in all positions on April 1, 1971 totaled 34.7 million bushels, 41 percent more than a year earlier and the highest for the quarter since 1944. At 24.2 million bushels, off-farm holdings were up 42 percent from a year earlier while on-farm stocks increased 39 percent.

Indicated disappearance during January-March was 6.7 million bushels compared with 5.3 million for the same period a year earlier. The Commodity Credit Corporation owned 17.4 million bushels of total rye stocks and had loans outstanding on 10.2 million bushels.

Corn stocks in all positions on April 1, 1971 totaled 2,531 million bushels -- down 15 percent from a year earlier and smallest since 1956. Off-farm stocks of 670 million bushels were 13 percent less than a year ago and farm holdings of 1,861 million bushels were down 16 percent. Disappearance January-March was 1,212 million bushels, compared with 1,325 million bushels a year earlier. Of the total corn stocks, the Commodity Credit Corporation owned 150 million bushels and had loans outstanding on an additional 543 million bushels.

Oats stored in all positions on April 1, 1971 totaled 702 million bushels -- up 4 percent from a year earlier and the highest April 1 stocks on record. The 198 million bushels held off farms was 54 million bushels over April 1, 1970, and responsible for the record high oats stocks. Farm holdings dropped 5 percent from a year earlier -- from 529 million bushels to 504 million bushels. January-March disappearance was 213 million bushels, compared with 211 million bushels for the same quarter in 1970. The Commodity Credit Corporation owned 142 million bushels of oats and had loans outstanding on 231 million more bushels.

Barley in storage April 1, 1971 totaled 259 million bushels, 22 percent below a year earlier. Farm holdings, at 142 million bushels, were down 28 percent from April 1, 1970, while off-farm stocks, at 117 million bushels, were off 12 percent. Disappearance from all storage positions January-March was 122 million bushels, 27 million bushels above the same 1970 period. Of the total barley stocks, the Commodity Credit Corporation owned nearly 24 million bushels and had loans outstanding on 82 million more bushels.

Sorghum grain stored in all positions on April 1, 1971, totaled 359 million bushels, 29 percent below a year earlier. Both on-farm and off-farm stocks are sharply below a year ago. Farm holdings of 91 million bushels were down 26 percent; off-farm holdings of 268 million bushels were 31 percent below stocks on the same 1970 date.

April 1 stocks indicate a January-March disappearance of 255 million bushels, up 37 percent from the 187 million bushels used during the same quarter last year. This is the largest January-March disappearance since the 295 million bushels in 1967. Drought in the Southwest spurred an increase in sorghum grain feeding.

The Commodity Credit Corporation owned 132 million bushels of total sorghum grain stocks and had loans outstanding on an additional 38 million bushels.

Soybeans in storage on April 1, 1971 totaled 619 million bushels, 16 percent less than a year earlier. Farm stocks were 20 percent bigger at 250 million bushels, but off-farm stocks of 369 million bushels were down 30 percent. The Commodity Credit Corporation owned 23 million bushels of the soybeans in storage and had loans outstanding on another 133 million bushels.

April 1 stocks indicate a disappearance during September-March of 746 million bushels from a beginning supply of 1,366 million bushels (carryover of 230 million bushels plus 1970 production of 1,136 million bushels). During the past 7 months, approximately 445 million bushels were processed for oil and about 270 million bushels were exported.

During January-March disappearance totaled 330 million bushels, 3 percent above the same period a year earlier.

Flaxseed stocks in all storage positions on April 1, 1971 totaled 34 million bushels -- an increase of 23 percent over a year ago and well above past years. Flaxseed stored on the farm accounted for 9 million bushels, down 12 percent from a year earlier. However, off-farm stocks of 25 million bushels were 44 percent above April 1, 1970. Current stocks indicate a January-March disappearance of 5.2 million bushels, compared with 3.8 million bushels in the same quarter last year.

April 1 stocks indicate a 9-month disappearance of 17.4 million bushels from a supply of 51.8 million bushels. Disappearance during the 9 months included about 13.1 million bushels crushed and 2.9 million exported.

Of total flaxseed stocks, the Commodity Credit Corporation owned 18 million bushels and had loans outstanding on an additional 12 million bushels.
