


## **Grain: World Markets and Trade**

#### China Becomes World's Largest Wheat Importer in 2022/23



China wheat imports are forecast up to 12.0 million tons this year—the country's highest level of imports since 1995/96 when imports reached 12.5 million.

Domestic grain prices in China have remained high given the country's minimum support price policy and reduced auction activity amidst uncertainty surrounding the government's COVID-19 policies.



Chinese wheat prices have lingered around \$450/ton over the past year while Chinese corn prices have averaged above \$400/ton. Meanwhile, international wheat prices have trended lower over the past few months, falling below \$400/ton with ample exportable supplies from Australia, the European Union, and Canada.

Competitive pricing has prompted China to import large volumes of both milling and feed quality wheat. Australian wheat is especially competitive following 3 consecutive years of record crops. China continues to aggressively purchase Australian wheat supplies, with July-February imports up 66 percent compared to the previous year. Imports from Canada, which supplies hard red milling wheat to the Chinese market, are up 83 percent year over year.

With international wheat at a discount to domestic grain, some Chinese feed mills have substituted corn with imported wheat in feed rations. Although China's wheat feed use is down year over year as corn feed use rebounds, it still represents a quarter of the country's total wheat consumption. Food, seed, and industrial use, meanwhile, remains robust.


## <u>WHEAT</u>

#### **OVERVIEW FOR 2022/23**

Global production is forecast slightly higher this month as a production increase for Ethiopia is only partially offset by reductions for Argentina, the European Union, and Saudi Arabia. Global trade is down with reduced exports from Argentina, Brazil, and the EU offsetting greater Black Sea exports which continue to flow with competitive prices and an extension of the Black Sea Grain Initiative. Imports are forecast down with reductions for Indonesia and many countries in Asia and South America. Total consumption is up significantly in China and the EU on more wheat feed and residual use; food, seed, and industrial (FSI) consumption is up in India. The U.S. season-average farm price forecast is lowered 10 cents to \$8.90 per bushel.

#### WHEAT PRICES

<u>Domestic</u>: Since the March *WASDE*, U.S. quotes have fallen for all classes except Hard Red Winter (HRW). HRW prices rose \$22/ton as dry conditions returned to the already drought-affected areas in the Southern Plains. Hard Red Spring (HRS) prices were nearly unchanged, down \$3/ton from last month to \$371 on slow demand. Soft White Winter (SWW) fell \$14/ton to \$298 as prices declined in key competitor Australia. Soft Red Wheat (SRW) fell \$21/ton to \$285, reflecting favorable weather for the new-crop and downward pressure from international prices.

Global: Global wheat prices have fallen since the March *WASDE* for all origins, excluding the United States, with reduced import demand and the extension of the Black Sea Grain Initiative. Argentine quotes fell \$11/ton though they remain above other origins because of drought-induced tight supplies. Canadian quotes fell \$4/ton. Australian quotes fell \$10/ton on weaker demand for feed-quality wheat in South Korea and Southeast Asia. Russian quotes slipped \$20/ton on ample supplies. EU quotes fell \$15/ton on sustained competition from Black Sea exporters. U.S. HRW quotes, by contrast, rose \$22/ton on lower expected supply owing to drought conditions in key growing areas, becoming even less price competitive compared to major global suppliers.





#### MARKET FEATURE

#### Philippines Wheat Imports Decline on Lower Food and Feed Use





Philippines wheat imports were trimmed by a half million tons to 6.2 million this month, reflecting year-to-year declines for both food, seed, and industrial (FSI) and feed and residual uses. Updated information from industry contacts also resulted in a multi-year revision to rebalance the FSI and feed and residual categories.

While rice is the primary staple in the Philippines, wheat consumption had been climbing as consumers transitioned to more Western diets, including bread, pizza, pasta, donuts, and cakes. In 2019, the government eliminated quantitative restrictions on rice imports and shifted to a tariff<sup>1</sup>, resulting in substantially higher rice imports. This change reduced domestic rice prices and rice consumption began to climb again. Wheat consumption was further impacted by COVID-19 restrictions which reduced out-of-home consumption of wheat-based products. Tighter global supplies have further reduced the competitiveness of wheat-based products relative to rice due to higher relative prices. In addition, high sugar prices in the Philippines have reduced bakery profitability. With reduced purchases from the United States (its top milling wheat supplier) only partially offset by higher imports from Australia and Canada, Philippines wheat imports for food use are forecast lower in 2022/23.

The Philippines import data distinguishes between wheat that is fit for human consumption from other wheat. The Philippines also uses wheat for feed since high corn import tariffs (35 percent) historically made the use of wheat for feed a more competitive option. However, the lower corn tariff (5 percent from May 2022 to December 2023) is resulting in some additional imports of corn for feed use. The Philippines continues to grapple with the impact of African swine fever and highly-pathogenic avian influenza, which has constrained feed demand from the swine and poultry industries. Wheat is also commonly used in aquaculture feed, which has seen sustained growth but constitutes a small portion of the total feed use.


\*NOTE: From TY 2015/16 onward, Lebanon and Syria imports have been adjusted to match Lebanese Customs data. By aligning Lebanon imports with the Lebanese Customs data, the updated FSI use aligns closer with the country's estimated milling capacity. Previously, Lebanon's imports were derived from reported exports to Lebanon. However, large volumes of wheat shipments to Lebanon have reportedly been transshipped to Syria, where it is imported and consumed. The difference between exporters' reported data and Lebanese Customs data has been added to Syria wheat imports, raising Syria FSI consumption and stock levels.

## **RICE**

#### **OVERVIEW FOR 2022/23**

Global rice production is down slightly as smaller crops in Indonesia and Iraq offset a larger Bangladesh crop. Global consumption is nearly unchanged. Exports are projected higher, largely from Vietnam and Thailand, and imports are up mainly due to Indonesia. Global stocks are forecast lower with multi-year revisions made to the Philippines.

#### **RICE PRICES**



In the past month, U.S. quotes remained high at \$760/ton on this year's tighter supplies. Uruguayan prices increased \$25 to \$600/ton on large purchases from neighboring countries. Vietnamese prices jumped \$25 to \$485/ton and Thai prices rose \$26 to \$499/ton due to greater demand from principal markets, especially Indonesia. Pakistani quotes decreased \$23 to \$453/ton with limited buying interest, while Indian quotes remain at \$435/ton.


#### **Indonesia to Import More Rice to Replenish Stocks**


On March 27, the government of Indonesia announced its plan to import more rice this year to replenish emergency stocks. For MY 2022/23 (January 2023 – December 2023), Indonesia is forecast to import 1.75 million tons.


Indonesia is typically almost self-sufficient for rice as the fourth largest rice producer globally. Imports generally average 600,000 tons a year, accounting for just 2 percent of total consumption. The Government of Indonesia procures rice from farmers to supply its distribution programs, stabilize rice prices, and to maintain sufficient emergency stocks. However, as a result of a smaller crop and the likelihood of a decline in government holdings, the Government of Indonesia plans to import up to 2.0 million tons of rice by the end of December 2023.

Rice imports would only represent 5 percent of Indonesia's total consumption, but the policy has a greater impact on global trade flows. During January-February 2023, Indonesia imported roughly 470,000 tons, mostly from Vietnam and Thailand. While the two countries will likely fulfill most of Indonesia demand, it is also possible to see more rice from India enter the market. Since 2021, India has captured more market share in Indonesia with its competitively low prices.

Historically, rice has been the primary staple grain in Indonesia, although wheat has become a more prominent part of the diet, leading to a decline in rice consumption in recent years. However, with high wheat prices in 2022/23, wheat consumption is declining, and rice consumption is holding steady.







#### **Philippines Rice Stocks Revision**

The Philippines rice consumption and stocks series has been updated back to 2014/15 based on market research. As noted in the wheat section, the favorable prices for rice compared to wheat have led to an upward revision in rice consumption. Rice consumption surged particularly after the policy change toward tariffication in 2019, which resulted in higher imports. This trend to higher rice consumption continued amid COVID-19 lockdowns and the heightened price of wheat as global supplies have tightened.

Meanwhile, Philippines rice stocks estimates have been lowered, better reflecting the tight stock situation, particularly in 2017/18 prior to tariffication. The National Food Authority, which had been the primary rice importer before tariffication, has a more limited scope for holding stocks, maintaining buffer stocks in the case of national emergency. The private sector now plays a larger role in holding pipeline stocks.


### **COARSE GRAINS**

#### **OVERVIEW FOR 2022/23**

Global corn production is forecast lower with substantial cuts to Argentina and the European Union which exceed a significant increase to Russia. Global trade is forecast lower this month as lower exports from Argentina, Burma, Mexico, and Serbia are only partially offset by increased exports from Russia and Ukraine. Global imports are forecast slightly lower this month with cuts in Egypt, Thailand, the United States, and Venezuela exceeding higher imports for the EU, Turkey, and Uruguay. The U.S. season-average farm price is unchanged at \$6.60 per bushel.


#### **CORN PRICES**

Since the March *WASDE*, U.S. bids were up, while bids for Brazil and Ukraine declined slightly. Argentine bids were virtually unchanged. U.S. bids were \$298/ton, up \$11. Sales to China have surged since the start of March, improving the outlook for U.S. exports and in part supporting higher prices. Brazilian bids were down \$5/ton to \$288. April will be a critical month for crop development in Brazil's Center-West, a key corn-growing region. Argentine bids were \$301/ton, unchanged from last month. Elevated prices for Argentina corn reflect tight supplies due to widespread drought. Ukrainian bids were \$243/ton, down \$13. Large overland export volumes to partners in the European Union and sustained exports under the Black Sea Grain Initiative (BSGI), which was extended for at least 60 days on March 18, are easing prices.



#### MARKET FEATURE

#### Mexico's Demand for U.S. Corn Remains Strong

For the first 7 months of 2022/23 (September 2022-March 2023), combined shipments and sales of U.S. corn to Mexico reached 13.5 million tons. This is the third highest level on record, signaling robust Mexico demand for U.S. supplies. Mexico is the largest market for U.S. corn exports, comprising over one-quarter of all U.S. corn exports in 2021/22.

Sustained Mexico demand for imports of U.S. corn is attributed to increasing demand for livestock products. The majority of Mexico corn production is white corn for food use, but 90-95 percent of the yellow corn needed for animal feed use and some industrial applications is imported from the United States. A lack of water in rain-fed areas (that constitute as much as two-thirds of Mexico corn area) constrains corn production, necessitating significant imports of yellow corn from the United States to meet growing feed demand. Moreover, per IGC data, U.S. supplies offer competitive prices with average prices for U.S. corn at \$265/ton over the past year \$10-\$20/ton cheaper than prices from Argentina and Brazil, respectively.

Competitive pricing is aided by the United States-Mexico-Canada Agreement (USMCA) and low-cost logistics due to U.S.-Mexico rail infrastructure. The USMCA maintains duty- and quota-free trade between the United States and Mexico. Rail linkages are robust, with 60 percent of U.S. corn exports to Mexico traveling by rail in 2022 per AMS Mexico Transportation Cost indicator report. The availability of transit options allows exporters to partially offset the impact of transport disruptions, such as high costs due to logistics bottlenecks during the COVID-19 pandemic or increased barge costs due to lower water levels in the Mississippi. Per data from the IGC, average freight prices for shipments of U.S. corn to the same destination in Mexico were as much as \$20/ton to \$40/ton cheaper than supplies from Brazil or Argentina in the September-March period over the past 4 years.

<u>Stocks:</u> Unless otherwise stated, stock data are based on an aggregate of differing local marketing years and should not be construed as representing world stock levels at a fixed point in time.

<u>Consumption</u>: World totals for consumption reflect total utilization, including food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste; as well as differences in local marketing year imports and local marketing year exports. Consumption statistics for regions and individual countries, however, reflect food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste only.

<u>Trade</u>: All PSD tables are balanced on the different local marketing years. All trade tables contain Trade Year (TY) data which puts all countries on a uniform, 12-month period for analytical comparisons: wheat is July/June; coarse grains, corn, barley, sorghum, oats, and rye are Oct/Sept; and rice is calendar year (TY 2022/23 corresponds to Jan – Dec 2023).

#### **EU Consolidation:**

Effective January 1, 2021, the separation of the United Kingdom (UK) from the European Union (EU) was complete, including trade between both entities. Starting in May 2021 with the release of 2021/22 data, field crops PSDs reflect EU27 (shown in the PSD system as "European Union") and UK separately.

Beginning with the release of 2021/22 data, historical data for both EU27 and the UK are provided for 5 years (2016/17 through 2020/21). The trade figures starting from 1999/00 through 2015/16 represent the European Union (EU27 plus UK) and exclude all intra-trade. For the years 1960/61 through 1998/99, figures are the EU-15 and also exclude all intra-trade. EU-15 member states' data for grains are no longer maintained in the official USDA database. Data for the individual NMS-10, plus Bulgaria, Romania, and Croatia, exists only prior to 1999/00.

Statistics: (1) Wheat trade statistics include wheat (1001), flour (1101), bulgur (190430), and selected pasta products (190219, 190230, and 190240) on a grain-equivalent basis (all wheat flour and products are multiplied by 1.368). (2) Rice trade statistics include rough (100610), brown (100620), milled (100630), and broken (100640) on a milled-equivalent basis (rough rice is multiplied by 0.7 and brown rice is multiplied by 0.875). (3) Coarse grains statistics include corn, barley, sorghum, oats, rye, millet, and mixed grains but exclude trade in barley malt, millet, and mixed grains.
